How can I help?

Reporting to the Fundraising Team, assist in generating partnerships/sponsorships from local businesses and organizations for the KMs for CCD fundraising event. Funds raised will support CCD's vital programs and services.

What is expected of me?

Flexible hours based on your availability with a time commitment of approximately 5-10 hours per week until the end of June 2023. May be required to travel to local businesses and/or the CCD Hub office. Using your knowledge of the local community and networking skills, duties may include:

- Research potential partners and sponsors for financial and/or in-kind donations.
- Compile a list of names to contact.
- Engage with potential partners and sponsors by phone or email (may be required to visit in person).
- Promote and communicate details of the event (e.g. Sponsorship Tool Kit, recognition incentives for participants).
- Sponsorship materials, templates and postage will be provided.
- Option of mileage reimbursement.

What training will I receive?

- Satisfactory Police Vulnerable Sector Check.
